

## POST-DOC POSITIONS IN ECONOMICS AND/OR FINANCE AT LUND UNIVERSITY, SWEDEN

The Department of Economics, Lund University invites applications for post-doc positions in Economics or Finance. Lund University is an internationally top ranked university, in the top 100-list of the Times Higher Education ranking, and is one of the largest universities in Scandinavia. The Department of Economics is an active research and teaching institute with a full scale postgraduate program. It has a long history of world class scholarship, having hosted economists like Knut Wicksell and Erik Lindahl, and is currently undergoing a strong expansion. Lund is an old attractive university town 10 minutes from Malmö and 40 minutes from Copenhagen.

We wish to fill these positions no later than September 2012, although there is room for some flexibility. The positions are for two or three years with a possible extension of an additional three years, and come with a competitive teaching and salary package. Although they are not tenure-track positions, other tenured positions are regularly opened-up at the department, and all non-tenured researchers are encouraged to apply.

The positions are open for any field within Economics or Finance. Applicants should hold a recent PhD, or be close to finishing their thesis. Interested candidates should email their applications to [application@nek.lu.se](mailto:application@nek.lu.se) before December 1, 2011. The application should include a detailed CV with a list of publications and working papers, one job market paper, the names and addresses of three referees, and a cover letter describing your future research plans. An additional publication/working paper may be included in the application, but it should be made clear which paper is considered to have most merit.

The successful candidates will be expected to carry out research suitable for publication in highly ranked journals in general economics, finance or specialized fields. Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed at the ASSA Chicago meeting in January 2012 or at the department in Lund.
