

## PhD position in management

### University of Neuchâtel, Switzerland

The Institute of Management at the University of Neuchâtel is opening a funded PhD position, 70%, in management with a research focus on strategy and organizational theory starting **August 1, 2019 or upon agreement.**

#### Position details

- Complete a PhD thesis in management under the supervision of Prof. Claudia Jonczyk Sédès
- Collaborate with the team in research and other scholarly activities
- Assist in administrative, teaching and research support for the supervisor (elaboration of course material, exam preparation, etc.)

#### Requirements

- Master's degree in management or in a related social science discipline (psychology, sociology, political science, statistics)
- An interest in several of the following topics: Strategy, organizational theory/organization studies, networks and social capital
- Demonstrated skills in empirical research methods (e.g. content analysis, grounded theory, survey research, case study analysis) and tools (e.g. NVIVO, SPSS, STATA, UCINET)
- Passion for research
- Ability to work independently and take initiative
- Ability to work in a multicultural environment
- Excellent command of English (oral and written)
- Good command of French or willingness to learn French

#### We offer excellent conditions

- Dynamic research environment with focus on empirical work.
- Funded position with personal workspace and excellent research infrastructure.
- Contract term of four years.
- Salary: 2018 gross annual salary, 1<sup>st</sup> year of employment at 70%: CHF 48'679.-

#### University background

The University of Neuchâtel is a university on a human scale, with about 4'500 students. Its small size enables it to provide high-level training and to foster relationships between students and professors. It is one of the most international universities in Switzerland, with about 100 nationalities present and more than a fifth of the student body coming from abroad. Ideally located midway between Geneva and Zürich, in the heart of Europe, it is a perfect place to study or undertake high-level research in an idyllic setting between lake and mountains.
