Abstract - “It has been more than a decade since the Global Financial Crisis (GFC) began. The successful utilization of monetary policy has stabilized the advanced economies. Central banks kept policy rates low and used unconventional monetary stimulus to help the recovery. They expanded their policy toolkit with quantitative easing, forward guidance and negative interest rates. It prevented a financial meltdown and a 21st century global depression. But growth is not back everywhere on a high and sustainable track. What are the challenges for monetary policy?”



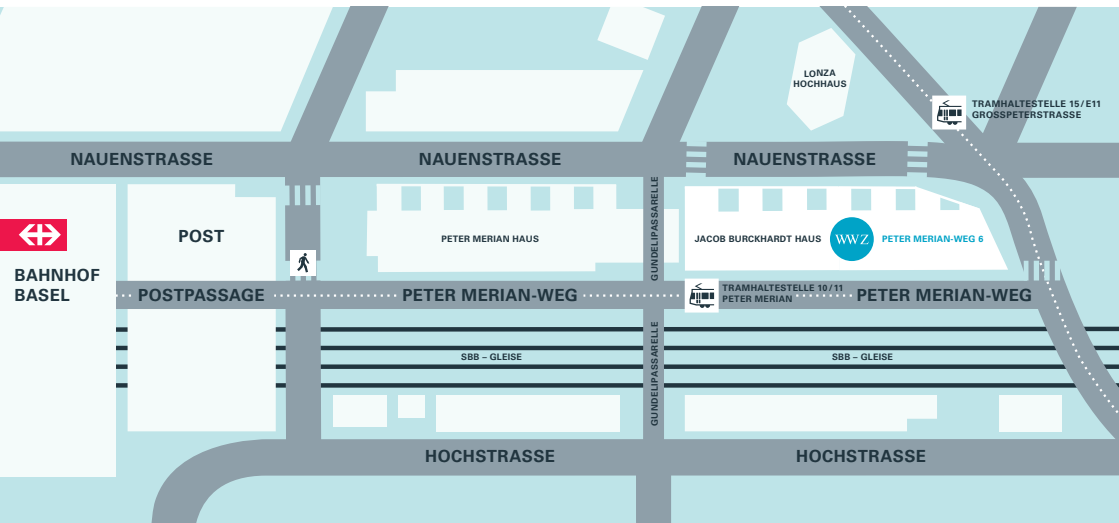

Luiz Pereira da Silva has been Deputy General Manager of the BIS since 2015. Before joining the BIS, Mr Pereira had held several positions in Brazil: Deputy Finance Minister in charge of international affairs, Deputy Governor of the Central Bank of Brazil and Chief Economist at the Ministry of Budget and Planning. He has also served with the World Bank in Washington DC, Tokyo and southern Africa. He holds a doctorate in economics and MPhil from Panthéon-Sorbonne University and graduated from HEC Paris and Science Po in Paris. He recently published with Pierre-Richard Agénor the book “Integrated inflation targeting - Another perspective from the developing world¹”.
