«Global Supply Chains and International Business Cycle»

Prof. Dr. Andrei Levchenko, John W. Sweetland Professor of International Economics at the University of Michigan

After decades of globalization, production has become a global activity, with supply chains overlapping with country borders. Participation in the global supply chains exposes countries to foreign business cycle shocks and supply chain disruptions. This talk will discuss a research program that builds sophisticated yet tractable and trans-parent models of the global supply chain and uses them to analyze cross-border transmission of shocks and the nature of international business cycle comovement.
